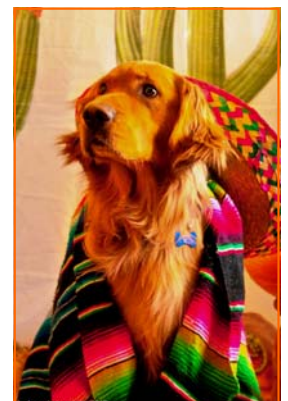

A NEW WAY TO HELP THE GOLDENS THIS YEAR!

As a few feature this year, we are kicking off the live auction with a special call for donations to purchase a Complete Blood Count (CBC) Machine. Due to the cost of “outsourcing” canine blood tests (\$50 per dog), we must limit our testing to those dogs who are five years old and over. However, we all know early disease/parasite detection is the key to ensuring healthy adoptions. By doing our own testing on our own premises, we’ll be able to save money as well as identify and treat problems earlier.

The cost of the machine is \$17,000 with annual maintenance fees around \$1,000. If we are able to test all dogs who come through our doors, the machine will pay for itself in the first year and we’ll have happier, healthier Golden Retrievers! It’s another way for YOU to make a difference in the lives of these wonderful dogs.

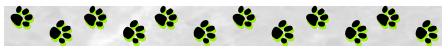
